

CULTIVATION GUIDE

Tahitian Lime

GROW HEALTHY TREES WITH THESE TIPS

SUNNY SPOT

Likes a sunny location with 6-8 hours of direct sunlight daily, shielded from strong winds. Can grow in containers indoors.

GOOD SOIL

Opt for well draining, slightly acidic to neutral (pH 6.0 - 7.5).

PLANT RIGHT

Plant with the graft union above the soil level. Choose a well-draining container.

WATER WISELY

Deep, regular watering let soil dry out between watering, especially for container grown limes.

FEED SMART

Use citrus fertilizer in late winter or spring, avoiding excessive nitrogen

PRUNE WELL

Trim for shape and air circulation in late winter or early spring. Remove unhealthy growth.

PEST CONTROL

Watch for aphids, scale insects and spider mites. Use natural or chemical controls. Be vigilant against diseases.

HARVEST RIGHT

Harvest when bright green and firm; use pruning shears.

STORE WITH CARE

Store at room temperature briefly, refrigerate for weeks or freeze juiced lemons for long term use.

ENJOY

Bring the tropics to your backyard with your zest Tahitian Lime.
